#### **BUSINESS SPOTLIGHT Central Eyes Optometry**

t Central Eyes Optometry, Drs. April and Barrett Napier

have worked to create an environment that is the central place for all things related to patients' eyes and vision-hence the company name. "We aim to provide patients with excellent patient care and a better understanding of their eye health and visual system," the doctors say. They add that it's important for them to stay up-to-date on the latest technologies and treatments available to provide the best care possible while keeping services affordable.

Both doctors grew up in Northern Illinois and moved to Oregon when Dr. April started optometry school. After supporting his wife's academic goals and watching her pursue her dreams, Dr. Barrett, a paramedic, decided to go back to school for optometry as well. Dr. April completed her doctorate in optometry and served in the Air Force as an optometrist and officer, and Dr. Barrett finished his doctorate during this time. The pair felt at home in Grants Pass right away and knew they had chosen the right place to live and work.

Central Eyes Optometry is a small clinic that focuses on patients and their eye health. Drs. April and Barrett have experience in caring for patients of all ages. They are InfantSEE providers who conduct initial eye screenings for infants from 6–12 months of age at no cost. At their clinic, they provide primary eye care, such as glasses and contact lenses, and they're also trained to diagnose and manage eye disease, infections, and injuries. Beyond that, they offer unique services like hard-to-fit specialty contact lenses and myopia (near-sightedness) control to help slow down how fast kids' eyes change. Further, the doctors offer orthokeratology, which are lenses that act like retainers for the eyes that gently



and temporarily reshape the corneas to improve vision; these lenses are worn at night and removed during the day and are a great solution for those with active lifestyles.



#### **BUSINESS SPOTLIGHT Edward Jones – Susie Atondo**


