



MEET YOUR NEIGHBORS | Tyler and Corina Goens





r. Devin Nelson's path to starting C

Street Dental was not the straightest one, but the journey came with a host of experiences that helped shape his outlook on life and business.

Dr. Nelson wasn't one of those kids who knew what he wanted to be when he grew up—he instead lived off the idea that if he remained honest and worked hard, everything would work out. He faced a tough decision in his life when he didn't get into notoriously competitive dental school the first year he applied. "A left turn in life presented itself to take a job in Phoenix, Arizona to be a mascot," he explains. "That job was unique, fun, and I got to travel the world. At C Street Dental, the practice is equipped to handle all dental hygiene needs, including cleanings, fillings, crowns/bridges, implants, dentures, root canals, teeth removal, aligners, and teeth whitening. The building has up-to-date dental equipment and technology. There is X-ray software, including 3D imaging, that allows for more efficient treatment



out with a crown on their tooth in two hours; a dental laser; and TVs in every room to help patients relax while sitting in a dental chair. But most importantly, Dr. Nelson and his team treat their patients like they would want to be treat "I am not a salesman, I'm a dentist," he says. "My office will not tell you t dental treatment unless you need it. I don't want people to sell me on some I don't need, so my office won't do that to you." Moreover, patients at C Stre Dental can come into the office knowing they'll get the treatment they need in a timely fashion. Dr. Nelson says that he's also helped foster a solid network with dental specialists and medical physicians in the area so they can all work together to treat a patient's overall health.

After only two years in business, C Street Dental was voted Favorite Dentist in Grants Pass in 2022. Dr. Nelson shares that the practice's team is one of the main reasons why the company is doing so well. "They are good workers, team players, and fun people to be around," he says. "My patients often tell me how wonderful my staff are. Patients feel at ease in my office because of how they are treated from the moment they walk through the door."


