





Happy Holidays, Neighbors!




e hope you all are doing well and enjoying this amazing season of friendship, family, and fun! We know that it can be tough to get in the holiday spirit when the daily

#### PETABLE PET | Ginger, The Marmalade Cat






sophomore year and first team all-conference accolades in 2021.

#### BUSINESS SPOTLIGHT | Wood Burning by Marsha

iven her level of talent, it might surprise some that Marsha Wilson, owner


of Wood Burning by Marsha, is a self-taught artist. At her business, Marsha makes art through pyrography or woodburning; she works with a variety of mediums, burning images on wood, leather, and paper with heated metal tips. In this way, she combines incredible attention to detail, artistry, and creativity into distinctive pieces of art.

Marsha's journey to entrepreneurship started a decade and a half ago. "I began over 15 years ago playing around with a very simple handheld wood burner and found others who shared their experiences with me on Facebook," Marsha shares. She adds that the road to where she is now didn't come without challenges and obstacles to overcome. But she met these challenges head on and pursued the path she knew was the right one for her. "I



was beginning to show my art at outdoor festivals and trying to find local places to display when I separated from my first husband," she explains. "At that point, doing my wood burning became my full-time aspiration."

As the sole proprietor of her company, Marsha feels intensely committed to her business. She says that what sets her business apart is her ability to faithfully duplicate an image onto a surface, transforming ordinary pieces of wood, leather, or paper into pieces of art that people are proud to display in their homes, businesses, or anywhere else. Marsha explains that she takes pride in the unique aspect of the work she does — she says that some people have never heard of the wood burning type of art she creates or have never seen it done to the degree of artisanship that she works. Marsha takes very seriously her ability to capture minute details of the images she recreates for her art pieces, and she says her clients often appreciate the attention to detail she brings to each project.





But Marsha is more than an artist and business owner; the Klamath Falls resident lived an interesting and eclectic life before becoming an entrepreneur. She has five daughters and took on the task of homeschooling each of the girls. But that isn't the only monumental role she's decided to work toward: Marsha also served as a full-time missionary in Ukraine and India. She adds that, thanks to her husband's job, she's been able to travel to shows and meet many wonderful people.

Marsha's mission with Wood Burning by Marsha is to capture memories and make them available for future generations to appreciate. She feels grateful that she's able to make a living as an artist who brings such joy to others through the art she creates, and she wants to continue delighting others in the Grants Pass community and beyond with the work she is so proud of. Marsha also offers a bit of inspiration to others who might be ready to pursue their own dreams: "The only limits are our imaginations."

#### **INGREDIENTS - Combine:**

2 1/2 cups flour

1 cup sugar

1 cup butter (softened)

1 teaspoon baking powder

2 tablespoons orange juice

1 tablespoon vanilla

\*double for extra cookies\*

Beat at low speed 1-3 & then 2-3. Divide into 3 parts, wrap in waxed paper and refrigerate until firm 2 to 3 hours. Roll out dough 1/3 at a time to 1/4 inch thick.

Place on an ungreased pan 400 degrees for 6-8 minutes.

#### Frosting:

4 cups powdered sugar

1/2 cup butter (softened)

3 to 4 tablespoons milk

2 teaspoons vanilla

Beat until fluffy




