# BUSINESS SPOTLIGHT | Logos Public Charter School



he Grants Pass
community is home
to a unique schooling
option that offers personalized

Logos Public Charter School is an accredited K-12th grade free public charter school that is sponsored by the Medford School District. LPCS has 1,200 students in Jackson and Josephine Counties, making it the largest nonvirtual charter school in Oregon. "The purpose of Logos Public Charter School is to graduate critical thinkers who can effectively communicate in the 21st century," Sheryl Zimmerer, executive director at LPCS, says. "Logos facilitates a personalized learning program. We personalize education to meet our students' unique needs." Zimmerer adds that the educators at LPCS incorporate concepts of personalized learning, collegial relationships with parents, education in a "classroom without walls," and strong community partnerships.

According to Zimmerer, many of the students enrolled at LPCS don't fit in with the traditional school model. She says that some of the students came to LPCS





after struggling with a curriculum that moved too fast or too slow. Others sought an escape from drama or bullying at a previous school. Still others have health concerns that require greater flexibility. Some of the students at LPCS simply desire a more personalized approach to schooling. The mission at LPCS is to cater to all of these students in a variety of situations, providing performance- and standards-based learning programs that are personalized to each student and supported by the principles of learning styles, multiple intelligences, servicelearning, and vocational readiness. This individualized approach sets LCPS apart

from other education programs. "It's really a rare type of school, where students can take classes at school, online, or through our community partnerships," Zimmerer explains. "It really allows us to meet kids where they are at and help them achieve their goals for their future." One example of how the school is preparing students for the real world and secondary education is LPCS' Scholars program. This program allows students to take college classes and receive high school and college credits simultaneously. The Scholars program has proven to be successful: Zimmerer says that each year, they have LPCS students who graduate with associate's degrees.



In 2021, 12 students graduated with 16 college degrees while still in high school.

Zimmerer has been involved with LPCS since its inception, and she says the journey to this point and the experience she's had has been extremely rewarding. "Being on the ground since the beginning and seeing this school grow from a few hundred students and not even having a school building at the beginning to 1,200 students on a beautiful campus in Medford

and another location serving Grants Pass has been one of my life's biggest blessings," she says. After several years in operation, Logos Public Charter School is thriving, with more students, programs, and opportunities than ever. Looking toward the future, the team at LPCS is excited to continue providing academic excellence through individualized education and promoting partnerships between families, the community, and public education.

# RECIPE | Winter Vegetable Chili



utternut squash, sweet parsnips, leeks, onions and chickpeas are the base of this vegetable-driven chile. The seasonings include chile powder, cinnamon, ginger, cilantro and hot pepper sauce. For an extra kick of flavor and texture, roast some chickpeas with cumin and chile pepper and sprinkle on top of the chili. It can be made two days ahead of time or frozen for up to a month.

#### Serves 4

#### **Ingredients**

- 11/2 tablespoons vegetable oil
- 2 cloves garlic, chopped
- 2 onions, thinly sliced
- 1 leek, white and light green sections thinly sliced
- Salt and fresh ground black pepper
- About 1 teaspoon ground cumin
- About 1 teaspoon ground ginger
- About 3/4 teaspoon chile powder
- About 1 teaspoon ground cinnamon
- 1 small butternut squash, about 1 1/2 pounds, peeled, deseeded, and cut into 1/2-inch cubes
- 2 medium carrots, peeled and cut into 1/2-inch cubes
- 2 parsnips, peeled and cut into 1/2-inch cubes
- 2 ribs celery, cut into 1/2-inch cubes
- 1 cup crushed tomatoes
- 1 cup cooked chickpeas, rinsed and drained
- 2 cups vegetable or chicken broth
- 1/4 cup fresh cilantro, coarsely chopped
- 1 tablespoon balsamic vinegar
- Splash hot pepper sauce
- Toppings: avocado cubes, chopped scallions, sour cream and roasted chickpeas (recipe below)



#### Instructions

In a medium to large pot, heat the oil over low heat. Add the garlic, onions and leek and cook, stirring, for 10 minutes. Add salt and pepper and half the cumin, ginger, chile powder and cinnamon. Stir and cook for about 30 seconds. Add the squash, carrots and parsnips, and stir into the spices; cook for 2 minutes. Raise the heat to high and add the celery, tomatoes, chickpeas and broth and bring to a boil. Add half the cilantro, reduce the heat to low and whisk in the remaining cumin, ginger, chile powder and cinnamon. Add salt and pepper to taste. Simmer, partially covered, for about 20 to 25 minutes, or until the squash and carrots are just tender and not falling apart. Add the vinegar and a splash of hot pepper sauce; season to taste.

Serve hot sprinkled with the remaining cilantro, avocado cubes, scallions, sour cream and roasted chickpeas, if desired.



Delaena is a bright, energetic kid who loves eating soft tacos





